

Parents and Guardians,

LearnZillion is a website that provides teachers and parents with video lessons showing what your student needs to learn each year. The videos include a 3-5 minute "teaching" video and a short "practice" video where students can see if they understand the lesson.

As discussed at Open House, flipped learning will start taking place at home this week! This means, your child will watch lessons/lectures at home (usually 5 minutes or less), complete a guided practice video-led activity (usually 3 minutes or less), and take notes as they go to bring to school to participate. The DAY each page is DUE TO SCHOOL is typed at the TOP of each NOTES PAGE. Complete, tear off, and return to school on the indicated date. The quiz is submitted online, so no paper turn-in is required.

HOW DO YOU START? Use the STAPLED REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS to help your child create an account. Once logged in, click on our class (Route #125) to see assignments. For this week, you have a video series (watch instructional video & guided practice) and culminating quiz.

This week's schedule is as follows: (This should take less than 15 min./night)

- DUE Wed., 9/18: Video #1 notes & guided practice
- DUE Thurs., 9/19: Video #2-3 notes & guided practice
- DUE Fri., 9/20: Video #4-5 notes & guided practice
- DUE Mon., 9/23: 4.NBT.3 QUIZ

Your student can watch the videos alone or with you. Have your student take notes while watching. I have provided a notes sheet to help. If your student doesn't have the notes sheet with them, he/she can recreate it by taking a piece of paper and breaking the front page into the following sections:

- What is this lesson about?
- Review
- Mistakes to avoid
- Notes & Mental Images
- GUIDED PRACTICE TASKS (click "guided practice" to right of video)
