## Five Point Activities

<p><b>Rainbow Words</b></p> <p>Write each of your words in pencil. Then, trace over your words with a crayon or colored pencil. Next, trace over your words with a different colored crayon or pencil. If you trace carefully, you'll see a rainbow!</p>	<p><b>Scrambled Words</b></p> <p>Have an adult scramble up your spelling words and then try to put the letters in their correct order.</p> <p>Example: ylap play</p>	<p><b>Be the Teacher</b></p> <p>Give an adult, babysitter, or older sibling a spelling test. Then carefully grade their answers.</p>
<p><b>Fall Scene</b></p> <p>Draw a picture of a fall scene and hide your spelling words in your drawing! Don't forget to make it colorful and detailed!</p>	<p><b>Type 'Em Up</b></p> <p>Type each of your spelling words on the computer. Change the font for each word.</p>	<p><b>Neon Words</b></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words neatly. Then highlight all the vowels with a yellow highlighter. After you have highlighted all the vowels, highlight the consonants with a different colored highlighter.</p>

## Ten Point Activities

<p><b>Broadcaster Spelling</b></p> <p>Pretend you are a new anchor, weather person, or reporter and use your spelling words to write a news report. You may use all your words in one news report or you may write as many reports as you need that only use some of your words until all your spelling words have been used.</p>	<p><b>Comic Strip Spelling</b></p> <p>Use your spelling words to write and illustrate a comic strip. You may use all your spelling words in one comic strip or you can write and illustrate as many comic strips that you need to until all your spelling words have been used.</p>
<p><b>Rhyme Time Spelling</b></p> <p>Write a short rhyme with each of your spelling words. Underline your spelling word and its rhyming word.</p> <p>Example: Fog. The big patch of <u>fog</u> made me trip and fall on a <u>log</u>.</p>	<p><b>Sentence Spelling</b></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words in a sentence that shows you understand its meaning.</p> <p>mows. My dad mows the grass when it gets to be too tall.</p>
